REQUIREMENTS

NOGA members will submit a written request (in confidence) to the Attention of the NOGA Board President at least **30 days prior** to the need of the funds. The NOGA Board must have a majority vote in order to approve the request for Scholarship Funds. A member shall be awarded only one request per year.

Any NOGA member that is interested and feels they qualify for the **JVEF**, should remit the following with their application:

1. State in a short paragraph what benefit this educational opportunity will provide. Explain how this training relates to the aging adult.
2. Is the training required for completion of hours needed to be recertified or renew your license? What field? Do you receive reimbursement from your employer?
3. Please list any reasons related to financial hardship (i.e. excessive educational costs, medical, single parent, etc.). You must supply a letter of support related to the hardship.

Following the educational program, you must send a copy of the CEU certificate or a receipt of payment to the NOGA Board President.
